COURSE WALK	The course will be available for walking from 2pm - 9.30pm on Saturday 28th August 2021. The gates will be closed & there will be no access before this time. The course may be walked on the day of the event with due care and attention to any horses on course. <b>DUE TO DOG FOULING ON COURSE - ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED TO ACCOMPANY COURSE WALKERS</b>

SHOW JUMPING	SJ will be a straightforward course of 8-10 fences				
CROSS COUNTRY	All tracks are designed to be straightforward and inviting with questions appropriate to the level. The smaller classes are suitable for first timers. 50cms may include non-fixed fences.				
DRESS CODE	Correct dress please, with the exception of Show Jackets during inclement weather. Hard hats conforming to the current British Standard must be worn at all times when mounted. Dressage:Tack as BD Rules 2021. XC:Body protector and non fixed peak hat upto current standards				
WITHDRAWALS, REFUNDS & SUBSTITUTIONS	Withdrawals by 7pm 13th August for refunds less £10. No refunds for whatever reason after this date. Substituting either a horse or rider there is a £5 admin charge. Changing both horse & rider in the same entry qualifies as a whole new entry & must be paid in full.				
EQUINE INFLUENZA	All horses must be up to date with their flu vaccs, either their annual vaccination, or the first 2 of their primary course plus 7 days.				
CATERING	Hot and cold food will be available throughout the event.				
NOTICES	Bibs nor paper numbers will be provided. you are responsible for printing your own number (size A4) Failure to wear a legible number will result in elimination				

OBJECTIONS ~ Anyone wishing to make an objection must do so in writing within 30 minutes of the incident happening along with a £50 deposit. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.

## **GENERAL RULES**

- The Event will be run in conjunction with BE Rules 2021 unless stated in this schedule.
- 2. All classes are open to juniors or seniors riding horses or ponies.
- 3. 4. Riders may only enter a maximum of 3 horses per day.
- Horses/Ponies must be 4 years old or older.
- 5. Hard hats upto the current British Standard must be worn at all times when mounted. No fixed peaks allowed.
- 6. Body protectors, BETA Level 3 (purple label) 2000 or 2009 label are compulsory. Air jackets may be worn over a body protector. Medical armbands strongly advised.
- 7. Any horse/pony considered to be unsound, unfit or unhealthy by a Judge, the Organiser or the Technical Advisor will be excluded from the competition without refund of entry.
- Scoring will be worked out on penalties. There will be an optimum time on the cross country course, penalties for which will be included in the score.
- 10. It is compulsory that every person at the venue who is under the age of 18 years of age is accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 11. No dogs will be allowed in or around any of the arenas or on the cross country course, they must stay in the lorry park or preferably remain at home. Please clean up after you dogs AND TAKE YOUR POO BAGS HOME.
- The Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry and to remove anyone from the course at any time without giving a reason. 12.
- The event may be cancelled without notice due to adverse weather. In the event of adverse weather it is recommended that you check the website 13. www.ashwoodequestrian.co.uk for any announcements. In the unlikely event of abandonment, entries may be carried over to a future event or refunded minus £5 admin fee.
