Ring 1 INFINITY ARENA – Show Jumping (Start 10.00am)

ENTRY FEE £12 per class

All classes open to horses/ponies ridden by juniors/seniors Rules in accordance with the current BS Rule Book.
Except that: Three refusals constitute elimination as per Riding Club rules.

- Class 1 30cms JUMPING**
Max height 30cm. Judged on faults not speed. All clears will be equal first. No prize money. Open to horses and ponies. Juniors, seniors and lead reins.
- Class 2 40cms JUMPING**
Max height 40cm. Judged on faults not speed. All clears will be equal first. No prize money. Open to horses and ponies. Juniors, seniors and lead reins.
- Class 3 50cms JUMPING**

- Max height 50cm. No fillers or back rails. Open to all. Juniors & Seniors will be split.
- Class 4 60cms JUMPING**
Max height 60cm. No fillers. Open to all. Juniors & Seniors will be split.
- Class 5 70cms JUMPING**
Max height in first round 70cm. Fences may go up 5cms in second round. Open to all. Juniors & Seniors will be split.
- Class 6 PAIRS JUMPING**
Two riders. First rider to jump 60cms. Second rider to jump 80cms. Horse or Pony any height, riders any age.
- Class 7 CHASE ME CHARLIE PONY**
Start height 60cms. Open to ponies not exceeding 148cms.
- Class 8 80cms JUMPING**
Max height in first round 80cm. Fences may go up 5cms in second round. Open to all. Juniors & Seniors will be split.
- Class 9 90cms JUMPING**
Max height in first round 90cm. Fences may go up 5cms in second round. Open to all. Juniors & Seniors will be split.
- Class 10 CHASE ME CHARLIE HORSE**
Start height 80cms. Open to horses exceeding 148cms.

Ring 2 DERBY ARENA – Working Hunter (Start 9.30am)

ENTRY FEE £12 per class

PHASE I Jump a course of Working Hunter fences, which will be natural looking rustic fences (no water splash)

PHASE II All horses/ponies completing Phase I will be invited back into the ring to perform an individual display.

Marks will be given for manners, turnout & showmanship. No mark for conformation.

Protective boots may be worn by the horse/pony for the jumping phase but must be removed for the showing phase.

Back Numbers or Bridle numbers must be worn in all classes, and must be printed at home.

Class 11 PRACTICE WORKING HUNTER

Entry fee £10. Enter on the gate. Max height 50cms. Horse or Pony any height, rider any age.

Clear Rounds to receive a rosette.

Class 12	LEAD REIN WORKING HUNTER PONY Max height 30cm. Riders 10 years and under on 1st January in the current year.
Class 13	CRADLE STAKES WORKING HUNTER PONY Max height 40cm. Open to ponies not exceeding 148cms. Riders 12 years and under on 1st January in the current year. Lead Rein allowed.
Class 14	NURSERY STAKES WORKING HUNTER PONY Max height 50cm. Open to ponies not exceeding 148cms. Riders 12 years and under on 1st January in the current year.
Class 15	JUNIORS BEGINNERS WORKING HUNTER Max height 60cm. Horse/Pony any height. To be ridden by a Junior, 16 years and under on the 1st January in current year.
CH2	MINI WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP 1 st & 2 nd prizewinners in Classes 12-15 are eligible for the MINI WH CHAMPIONSHIP
Class 16	SENIOR BEGINNERS WORKING HUNTER Max height 60cm. Horse/Pony any height. Riders 17 & over.
Class 17	Mountain & Moorland WORKING HUNTER Native Breeds only. To be shown in natural state. Max height 70cm. Rider any age.
Class 18	JUNIOR NOVICE WORKING HUNTER HORSE/PONY Max height 70cm. To be ridden by a Junior, 16 years and under on the 1st January in current year.
Class 19	SENIOR NOVICE WORKING HUNTER HORSE/PONY Max height 70cm. Riders 18 & over.
Class 20	COLOURED HORSE WORKING HUNTER HORSE/PONY Max height 70cm. Coloured, Spotted, & Palomino horses/ponies any height. Rider any age.
Class 21	INTERMEDIATE WORKING HUNTER HORSE/PONY Max height 80cm. Rider any age.
Class 22	OPEN WORKING HUNTER HORSE/PONY Max height 90cm. Rider any age.
CH2	WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP 1 st & 2 nd prizewinners in Classes 15-21 are eligible for the WH Championship

ENTRIES	On-line entries ashwoodequestrian.com £12 per class. Discount for Ashwood Members. £2.50 First Aid. Entries taken on the day £2 extra if time allows. Individual times given 2 days prior to the show ashwoodequestrian.com/times . STRICTLY NO HORSE OR PONY ALLOWED IN THE COLLECTING RING UNLESS PRE-ENTERED. CLASSES WILL RUN SINGLE PHASE.
ARENA 1 PRIZES	Winners sash to the winner. Rosettes to 6th place. Classes 3, 4, 5, 8 & 9 :10-15 starters: 1st £15, 16-20 starters: 1st £15, 2nd £8, 21+ starters: 1st £10, 2nd £8, 3rd £5. Competitors must jump clear in the first round to qualify for prize money. Prize money to be requested on the day or will be forfeited. Prizes in kind for the winners of the Pairs. Prize pot & Sash given to the winner of the Chase Me Charlie based on the number of entries.
ARENA 2 PRIZES	All prize winners must come forward for a mounted presentation or will forfeit their prize. The winners of classes 11 - 22 will receive a sash. Rosettes to 10th place in all classes. Championship sashes given to the Champion and Reserve of CH1 & CH2.

GENERAL INFORMATION

COURSE WALK	The course will be available for walking at the start of each class.

WITHDRAWALS, REFUNDS & SUBSTITUTIONS	Withdrawals by 12 noon the preceding Thursday may be taken as credit or refund less £5. After this time withdrawals for credit only will be considered if the event is full and your entry can be replaced. Substitution of horse or rider is possible. Changing both horse & rider in the same entry qualifies as a whole new entry & must be paid in full.
DRESS CODE (SHOW JUMPING)	Correct show jumping dress, with the exception of Show Jackets during inclement weather. Clean & Tidy please. No yard boots. Hard hats conforming to the current British Standard must be worn at all times when mounted. NO SCHOOLING WHIPS AT ANY TIME.
DRESS CODE (WORKING HUNTER)	Correct show dress, light coloured breeches/jods with tweed show jackets. Spurs permitted for senior riders only. Clean & Tidy please. Horses & ponies are expected to be plaited unless a native breed which may be show in their natural state. Hard hats conforming to the current British Standard must be worn at all times when mounted. NO SCHOOLING WHIPS AT ANY TIME.

TERMS & CONDITIONS Save for death or injury by the negligence of the organiser or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, Ashwood Equestrian Ltd, for themselves, their servants, agents, employees and all those connected with the event do not accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury, illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or statutory duty in any way whatsoever of themselves, their servants, agents, employees and all those connected with the event or otherwise. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising thereto. The organiser does not insure the rider, your horse or your tack and equipment. You are strongly advised to have in place your own adequate personal accident insurance at all times.

The decision of the Judges is final. If any person wishes to lodge a complaint, this must be done so in writing within 30 minutes of the incident along with a deposit of £50 (which will be returned if the complaint is upheld).

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry and to remove anyone from the venue at any time without giving a reason, amend the details of the schedule should it become necessary, or to cancel any class with insufficient entries. Once a class has been entered, refunds will not be given.

GENERAL RULES

1. All classes are open to juniors or seniors riding horses or ponies.
2. Horses/Ponies must be 4 years old or older.
3. Any horse/pony considered to be unsound, unfit or unhealthy by a Judge or the Organiser will be excluded from the competition without refund of entry.
4. No horseboxes to be mucked out on site.
5. It is compulsory that every person at the venue who is under the age of 18 years of age is accompanied by a responsible adult.
6. No dogs will be allowed in or around any of the arenas or on the cross country course, they must stay in the lorry park or preferably remain at home. Please clean up after you dogs AND TAKE YOUR POO BAGS HOME.
7. The event may be cancelled without notice due to adverse weather. In the event of adverse weather it is recommended that you check the website www.ashwoodequestrian.com for any announcements. In the unlikely event of abandonment, entries may be carried over to a future event or refunded minus £5 admin fee.
