Marks will be given for manners, turnout & showmanship. No mark for conformation.

Ring 1 INFINITY ARENA – Working Hunter Performance

ENTRY FEE £12.50 per class

Back Numbers or Bridle numbers must be worn in all classes, and must be printed at home.

- Class 1 PRACTICE WORKING HUNTER**
Entry fee £10. Enter on the gate. Max height 50cms. Horse or Pony any height, rider any age. Clear Rounds to receive a rosette.
- Class 2 LEAD REIN WORKING HUNTER PONY**
Max height 30cm. Riders 10 years and under on 1st January in the current year.
- Class 3 CRADLE STAKES WORKING HUNTER PONY**
Max height 40cm. Open to ponies not exceeding 148cms. Riders 12 years and under on 1st January in the current year. Lead Rein allowed.
- Class 4 NURSERY STAKES WORKING HUNTER PONY**
Max height 50cm. Open to ponies not exceeding 148cms. Riders 12 years and under on 1st January in the current year.
- Class 5 JUNIORS BEGINNERS WORKING HUNTER**
Max height 60cm. Horse/Pony any height. To be ridden by a Junior, 16 years and under on the 1st January in current year.
- CH1 MINI WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP**
1st & 2nd prizewinners in Classes 2-5 are eligible for the MINI WH CHAMPIONSHIP
- Class 6 SENIOR BEGINNERS WORKING HUNTER**
Max height 60cm. Horse/Pony any height. Riders 17 & over.
- Class 7 Mountain & Moorland WORKING HUNTER**
Native Breeds only. To be shown in natural state. Max height 70cm. Rider any age.
- Class 8 JUNIOR NOVICE WORKING HUNTER HORSE/PONY**
Max height 70cm. To be ridden by a Junior, 16 years and under on the 1st January in current year.
- Class 9 SENIOR NOVICE WORKING HUNTER HORSE/PONY**
Max height 70cm. Riders 18 & over.
- Class 10 COLOURED HORSE WORKING HUNTER HORSE/PONY**
Max height 70cm. Coloured, Spotted, & Palomino horses/ponies any height. Rider any age.
- Class 11 INTERMEDIATE WORKING HUNTER HORSE/PONY**
Max height 80cm. Rider any age.
- Class 12 OPEN WORKING HUNTER HORSE/PONY**
Max height 90cm. Rider any age.
- CH2 WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP**
1st & 2nd prizewinners in Classes 6-12 are eligible for the WH Championship

ENTRIES	Pre-Entries close Wednesday 31st August. On-line entries ashwoodequestrian.com £12.50 per class. Discount for Ashwood Members. £2.50 First Aid. Entries taken on the day £2 extra if time allows. Individual times given 2 days prior to the show ashwoodequestrian.com/times . STRICTLY NO HORSE OR PONY ALLOWED IN THE COLLECTING RING UNLESS PRE-ENTERED.
ARENA 1 PRIZES	All prize winners must come forward for a mounted presentation or will forfeit their prize. The winners of classes 2 - 12 will receive a sash. Rosettes to 10th place in all classes. Championship sashes given to the Champion and Reserve of CH1 & CH2.

GENERAL INFORMATION

COURSE WALK	The course will be available for walking at the start of each class.
WITHDRAWALS, REFUNDS & SUBSTITUTIONS	Withdrawals by 12 noon Thursday 1st September may be taken as credit or refund less £5. No withdrawals for any reason after this time. Substitution of horse or rider is possible. Changing both horse & rider in the same entry qualifies as a whole new entry & must be paid in full.

DRESS CODE	Correct show dress, light coloured breeches/jods with tweed or plain coloured show jackets. Spurs permitted for senior riders only.
(WORKING HUNTER)	Clean & Tidy please. Horses & ponies are expected to be plaited unless a native breed which may be show in their natural state. Hard hats conforming to the current British Standard must be worn at all times when mounted. NO SCHOOLING WHIPS AT ANY TIME.

TERMS & CONDITIONS Save for death or injury by the negligence of the organiser or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, Ashwood Equestrian Ltd, for themselves, their servants, agents, employees and all those connected with the event do not accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury, illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or statutory duty in any way whatsoever of themselves, their servants, agents, employees and all those connected with the event or otherwise. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising thereto. The organiser does not insure the rider, your horse or your tack and equipment. You are strongly advised to have in place your own adequate personal accident insurance at all times.

The decision of the Judges is final. If any person wishes to lodge a complaint, this must be done so in writing within 30 minutes of the incident along with a deposit of £50 (which will be returned if the complaint is upheld).

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry and to remove anyone from the venue at any time without giving a reason, amend the details of the schedule should it become necessary, or to cancel any class with insufficient entries. Once a class has been entered, refunds will not be given.

GENERAL RULES

1. All classes are open to juniors or seniors riding horses or ponies.
2. Horses/Ponies must be 4 years old or older.
3. Any horse/pony considered to be unsound, unfit or unhealthy by a Judge or the Organiser will be excluded from the competition without refund of entry.
4. No horseboxes to be mucked out on site.
5. It is compulsory that every person at the venue who is under the age of 18 years of age is accompanied by a responsible adult.
6. No dogs will be allowed in or around any of the arenas or on the cross country course, they must stay in the lorry park or preferably remain at home. Please clean up after you dogs **AND TAKE YOUR POO BAGS HOME.**
7. The event may be cancelled without notice due to adverse weather. In the event of adverse weather it is recommended that you check the website www.ashwoodequestrian.com for any announcements. In the unlikely event of abandonment, entries may be carried over to a future event or refunded minus £5 admin fee.
