



## MINI EVENTING 2023

At Ashwood Head Farm, Stafford Road, Knightley. ST20 0JR

### FOR HORSES AND PONIES - OPEN TO ALL

**MINI EVENTING is a 2-phase event (SJ & XC) from 30cms to 50cms.** The competition will consist of a course of Show Jumps in an enclosed grass arena, after which you will go straight onto the XC phase. There will be a minute to have a breather while you enter the XC start box and wait for the XC controller to count you down! The XC phase will be a shortened course with all the obstacles in one field. The XC phase will be timed with an undisclosed Optimum Time running at 325mpm. Penalties will be given for jumping faults and time faults. The horse & rider with the least accumulated penalties will be the winner.

\*Both phases will take place on grass. However in the event of bad weather both phases will be moved to the all-weather surface.

### Ring 1 INFINITY ARENA – SHOWCROSS

#### **ENTRY FEE £26.00 per class**

Juniors and Seniors riding Horses or Ponies may compete in all classes. Lead Reins and assistance is permitted in Classes 1 & 2. Assistance is allowed in Class 3.

All classes will be judged together, with the results being split Juniors/Seniors.

<b>ENTRIES</b>	Pre-Entries close the day before the event or when full. On-line entries <a href="http://ashwoodequestrian.com">ashwoodequestrian.com</a> £26 per class. Discount for Ashwood Members. First Aid included in the entry fee. Entries taken on the day £3 extra if time allows. Times given 2 days prior to the show <a href="http://ashwoodequestrian.com/times">ashwoodequestrian.com/times</a> . STRICTLY NO HORSE OR PONY ALLOWED IN THE COLLECTING RING UNLESS PRE-ENTERED.
<b>PRIZES</b>	Premier Rosettes awarded to 10th place in all classes with prizes in kind for the winners.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

<b>COURSE WALK</b>	The course will be available for walking on the day at the start of each class.
<b>DRESS CODE</b>	XC Attire to be worn. Clean & Tidy please. Any colour jods/tops/jackets. Correctly fitting Hard hats (NO FIXED PEAKS) & Body Protectors conforming to the current British Standard must be worn at all times when mounted, with proper riding boots (no yard boots). Horses & ponies do not need to be plaited. NO SCHOOLING WHIPS AT ANY TIME.
<b>SHOW JUMPING</b>	SJ will be a straightforward course of 8-10 fences in an enclosed grass arena. No fillers or spreads in any class.
<b>CROSS COUNTRY</b>	All tracks will be suitable for first timers. The XC phase will take part in one field, which will be strung off to assist where appropriate. There will only be one horse on the XC at any one time.
<b>WITHDRAWALS, REFUNDS &amp; SUBSTITUTIONS</b>	Withdrawals by 12 noon the preceding Monday may be taken as credit or refund less £5. No withdrawals for any reason after this time. Substitution of horse or rider is possible. Changing both horse & rider in the same entry qualifies as a whole new entry & must be paid in full.
<b>NOTICES</b>	Bibs nor paper numbers will be provided. You are responsible for printing your own number (size A4)
<b>CATERING</b>	Hot and cold food will be available throughout the event.

**TERMS & CONDITIONS** Save for death or injury by the negligence of the organiser or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, Ashwood Equestrian Ltd, for themselves, their servants, agents, employees and all those connected with the event do not accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury, illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or statutory duty in any way whatsoever of themselves, their servants, agents, employees and all those connected with the event or otherwise. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising thereto. The organiser does not insure the rider, your horse or your tack and equipment. You are strongly advised to have in place your own adequate personal accident insurance at all times.

The decision of the Judges is final. If any person wishes to lodge a complaint, this must be done so in writing within 30 minutes of the incident along with a deposit of £50 (which will be returned if the complaint is upheld).

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry and to remove anyone from the venue at any time without giving a reason, amend the details of the schedule should it become necessary, or to cancel any class with insufficient entries. Once a class has been entered, refunds will not be given.

### **GENERAL RULES**

1. All classes are open to juniors or seniors riding horses or ponies.
2. Horses/Ponies must be 4 years old or older.
3. Any horse/pony considered to be unsound, unfit or unhealthy by a Judge or the Organiser will be excluded from the competition without refund of entry.
4. No horseboxes to be mucked out on site.
5. It is compulsory that every person at the venue who is under the age of 18 years of age is accompanied by a responsible adult.
6. No dogs will be allowed in or around any of the arenas or on the cross country course, they must stay in the lorry park or preferably remain at home. Please clean up after you dogs AND TAKE YOUR POO BAGS HOME.
7. The event may be cancelled without notice due to adverse weather. In the event of adverse weather it is recommended that you check the website [www.ashwoodequestrian.com](http://www.ashwoodequestrian.com) for any announcements. In the unlikely event of abandonment, entries may be carried over to a future event or refunded minus £5 admin fee.
