*TRAILBLAZERS SECOND ROUND 2023

Intro A, Prelim 13, Novice 32 and Elementary 42 (Seniors) include a second round qualifier for Trailblazers 2023. Classes will be split Junior/Senior. The top 7 in each Class will qualify. You must bring your Second Round Qualification Form to the secretary for signing.

To obtain a Second Round Qualification Form you must have qualified with a score of 58% or over in a First Round and purchased a qualification card from the Venue at which you qualified. That Qualification Card must then be sent to the Trailblazers Show Secretary who will send you the Second Round Qualification Form.

You may qualify in a second round at a different venue from the first round.

ENTRIES	On-line entries <u>ashwoodequestrian.com</u> . Discounted entries for Ashwood Members. Entries close when full. Entries may be capped in each class. Advanced medical responder on-site. Individual times will be given 2 days prior to the show <u>ashwoodequestrian.com/times</u> Junior/Senior will be split.
WITHDRAWALS, REFUNDS & SUBSTITUTIONS	Withdrawals upto 7 days before the show may be taken as credit or refunded less £5. Substituting either a horse or rider may be possible. Changing both horse & rider in the same entry qualifies as a whole new entry & must be paid in full.
DRESS CODE	Tack as British Dressage Rulebook 2023. Two Bridle or Saddlecloth numbers to be worn, one on each side or the horse. Competitors must provide their own numbers. Correct show dress please. Hard hats conforming to the current British Standard must be worn at all times when mounted. Plaiting is at the discretion of the rider but is preferred as courtesy to the judge.

TRAILBLAZERS	This show is a First Round Qualifier for Trailblazer Championships Finals 2023. Compete in a First Round to qualify for a Second Round. Compete in a Second Round to qualify for the Trailblazer Championship finals. In a First Round you need to score 58% or over and purchase a Qualification Card (£12) from the Ashwood Secretary to qualify for a Second Round. Compete in a Second Round Qualifier at the level qualified in the First Round and gain a placing in a qualifier position to qualify for the Trailblazer Championship Finals 2023. SUNSHINE TOUR	This show is a qualifier for Sunshine Tour Championships at The All England Showground, Hickstead 14th-17th September 2023. The top 3 placed in each section will qualify. See https://www.sunshinetour.co.uk for full details.			
MIDARC	This show is affiliated to MIDARC and runs qualifiers for the Midland Championships - full details may be viewed at www.midarc.co.uk			
PRIZES	Premier Rosettes are awarded to 10th place in each class; prizes in kind will be awarded depending on the number of entries in the class.			
CATERING	Hot and cold food will be available throughout the event.			

TERMS & CONDITIONS Save for death or injury by the negligence of the organiser or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, Ashwood Equestrian Ltd, for themselves, their servants, agents, employees and all those connected with the event do not accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury, illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or statutory duty in any way whatsoever of themselves, their servants, agents, employees and all those connected with the event or otherwise. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising thereto. The organiser does not insure the rider, your horse or your tack and equipment. You are strongly advised to have in place your own adequate personal accident insurance at all times.

The decision of the Judges is final. If any person wishes to lodge a complaint, this must be done so in writing within 30 minutes of the incident along with a deposit of £50 (which will be returned if the complaint is upheld).

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry and to remove anyone from the venue at any time without giving a reason, amend the details of the schedule should it become necessary, or to cancel any class with insufficient entries.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. All classes are open to juniors or seniors riding horses or ponies.
- 2. Horses/Ponies must be 4 years old or older.
- 3. Any horse/pony considered to be unsound, unfit or unhealthy by a Judge or the Organiser will be excluded from the competition without refund of entry.
- 4. No horseboxes to be mucked out on site.
- 5. It is compulsory that every person at the venue who is under the age of 18 years of age is accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 6. No dogs will be allowed in or around any of the arenas or on the cross country course, they must stay in the lorry park or preferably remain at home. Please clean up after you dogs AND TAKE YOUR POO BAGS HOME.
- 7. The event may be cancelled without notice due to adverse weather. In the event of adverse weather it is recommended that you check the website www.ashwoodequestrian.com for any announcements. In the unlikely event of abandonment, entries may be carried over to a future event or refunded minus £5 admin fee.
