ENTRIES	On-line entries <u>ashwoodequestrian.com</u> £14.00 per class. £3.00 First Aid Contribution per rider per day; Medic will be on-site. Discount for Ashwood Members. Extra Entries taken on the day, no extra charge for pre-entered horses/riders entering additional classes, £3 fee for new entrants. Individual times given 2 days prior to the show <u>ashwoodequestrian.com/times</u> . STRICTLY NO HORSE OR PONY ALLOWED IN THE COLLECTING RING UNLESS PRE-ENTERED. CLASSES WILL RUN SINGLE PHASE. Run under BS Rules 2023 with the exception of 3 refusals for elimination. Junior/Senior sections will be split. Juniors riding horses will jump in the Senior section. Seniors & Juniors on Horses or Ponies are welcome to enter all classes.
PRIZES	Premier rosettes to 10th place (rosettes to every competitor in 30 & 40cms). Placings split Junior/Senior. Prize money in classes 4-11 according to number of starters.
30 & 40cms	Open to Lead Reins and Assisted riders. Juniors and Seniors are welcome to enter. Judged on faults not speed. All clear rounds will be equal 1st. Faults will be placed.
GRAND PRIX	Up to 2 rounds. All clears in the first round go forwards to a second jump off round over a shorter course against the clock. Fences may go up in the jump off.
SPEED CLASS	One round. The whole course is timed. The fastest time with the least faults will determine the winner.
SUNSHINE TOUR	This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All-England Showground Hickstead from Thursday 14th - Sunday 17th September 2023. The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors from Lead Rein to 1.05m. Qualification: 1st-3rd place. Qualification does not pass down the line. Visit www.sunshinetour.co.uk for more information, to register and submit evidence of results. Registration must be completed within 1 month of qualification (sooner for late July shows). Restrictions apply to horse and competitor's previous wirings and amateur status, please check the website www.sunshinetour.co.uk for Terms and Conditions.

GENERAL INFORMATION			
COURSE WALK	The course will be available for walking at the start of each class.		
ELIMINATIONS	Competitors incurring 3 refusals will be eliminated. You will be allowed to continue at the judges discretion. Fall of horse or rider will incur immediate elimination and you will not be allowed to continue. You will be required to see the on-site medic.		

WITHDRAWALS, REFUNDS & SUBSTITUTIONS

Withdrawals by 12 noon the preceding Thursday may be taken as credit. After this time withdrawals for credit only will be considered if the event is full and your entry can be replaced. Substitution of horse or rider is possible. Changing both horse & rider in the same entry qualifies as a whole new entry & must be paid in full.

DRESS CODE

Correct show jumping dress, with the exception of Show Jackets during inclement weather. Clean & Tidy please. No yard boots. Hard hats conforming to the current British Standard must be worn at all times when mounted. Plaiting is optional. NO SCHOOLING WHIPS AT ANY TIME.

TERMS & CONDITIONS Save for death or injury by the negligence of the organiser or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, Ashwood Equestrian Ltd, for themselves, their servants, agents, employees and all those connected with the event do not accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury, illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or statutory duty in any way whatsoever of themselves, their servants, agents, employees and all those connected with the event or otherwise. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising thereto. The organiser does not insure the rider, your horse or your tack and equipment. You are strongly advised to have in place your own adequate personal accident insurance at all times.

The decision of the Judges is final. If any person wishes to lodge a complaint, this must be done so in writing within 30 minutes of the incident along with a deposit of £50 (which will be returned if the complaint is upheld).

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry and to remove anyone from the venue at any time without giving a reason, amend the details of the schedule should it become necessary, or to cancel any class with insufficient entries. Once a class has been entered, refunds will not be given.

We do not tolerate abuse of any kind, to our staff, competitors or volunteers, either in person or on social media platforms or in any electronic form. Individuals displaying bullying, aggressive or intimidating behaviour or comments on social media will not be welcome to return.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. All classes are open to juniors or seniors riding horses or ponies.
- 2. Horses/Ponies must be 4 years old or older.
- 3. Any horse/pony considered to be unsound, unfit or unhealthy by a Judge or the Organiser will be excluded from the competition without refund of entry.
- 4. No horseboxes to be mucked out on site.
- 5. It is compulsory that every person at the venue who is under the age of 18 years of age is accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 6. No dogs will be allowed in or around any of the arenas or on the cross country course, they must stay in the lorry park or preferably remain at home. Please clean up after you dogs AND TAKE YOUR POO BAGS HOME.
- 7. The event may be cancelled without notice due to adverse weather. In the event of adverse weather it is recommended that you check the website www.ashwoodequestrian.com for any announcements. In the unlikely event of abandonment, entries may be carried over to a future event or refunded minus £5 admin fee.
