DAY 1 - JUNIORS

Ring 1 INFINITY ARENA – TREASURE TROVE WINTER CHAMPIONSHIPS

Start 10.00am

- Class 1 40cms TREASURE TROVE CHAMPIONSHIP**
Open to ponies 148cms & under ridden by juniors 16yrs and under.
Pony/Rider combination MUST have qualified at a TT qualifying show.
Max height of fences 40cms. No back rails or fillers. Assistance is allowed. To be judged Single Phase.
Fastest with least faults wins.
- Class 2 50cms TREASURE TROVE CHAMPIONSHIP**
Open to ponies 148cms & under ridden by juniors 16yrs and under.
Pony/Rider combination MUST have qualified at a TT qualifying show.
Max height of fences 50cms. No back rails or fillers. To be judged Single Phase. Fastest with least faults wins.
- Class 3 SUPER SONIC SIXTY**
Open to ponies 148cms & under ridden by juniors 16yrs and under.
Open to any Pony/Rider combination.
One round against the clock. Judged on the fastest time with 5 seconds added for each knockdown.
ONE attempt at an Optional Joker Fence +10cms (not timed) which if jumped clear will subtract 20 seconds from the time but if refused or knocked down will have 20 seconds added to the time.
Max height of fences 60cms.
- Class 4 60cms TREASURE TROVE CHAMPIONSHIP**
Open to ponies 148cms & under ridden by juniors 16yrs and under.
Pony/Rider combination MUST have qualified at a TT qualifying show.
Max height of fences 60cms. To be judged Single Phase.
- Class 5 70cms TREASURE TROVE CHAMPIONSHIP**
Open to ponies 148cms & under ridden by juniors 16yrs and under.
Pony/Rider combination MUST have qualified at a TT qualifying show.
Two rounds. Max height of fences in first round 70cms. Max height of fences in jump off 75cms. All clears in the first round go through to jump off against the clock. Fastest in round 2 with least faults wins.
- Class 6 80cms TREASURE TROVE CHAMPIONSHIP**
Open to ponies 148cms & under ridden by juniors 16yrs and under.
Pony/Rider combination MUST have qualified at a TT qualifying show.
Max height of fences 85cms in second half of the course. To be judged Single Phase. Fastest with least faults wins.
- Class 7 GO BIG OR GO HOME**
Open to any Pony/Rider combination.
Fence height starts at 60cms, increasing with each round. All clears go through to the next round, faults mean elimination. Winner is the last one in and jumps the highest clear.

DAY 2 - SENIORS

Ring 1 INFINITY ARENA – TREASURE TROVE WINTER CHAMPIONSHIPS

Start 10.00am

- Class 5 50cms TREASURE TROVE CHAMPIONSHIP**
Horse/Rider combination MUST have qualified at a TT qualifying show.
Max height of fences 50cms. No back rails or fillers. To be judged Single Phase. Fastest with least faults wins.
- Class 9 60cms TREASURE TROVE CHAMPIONSHIP**
Horse/Rider combination MUST have qualified at a TT qualifying show.
Max height of fences 60cms. To be judged Single Phase. Fastest with least faults wins.
- Class 10 SPEEDY 70**
One round against the clock. Judged on the fastest time with 5 seconds added for each knockdown. ONE attempt at an Optional Joker Fence +10cms (not timed) which if jumped clear will subtract 20 seconds from the time but if refused or knocked down will have 20 seconds added to the time.
Max height of fences 70cms.
- Class 11 70cms TREASURE TROVE CHAMPIONSHIP**
Horse/Rider combination MUST have qualified at a TT qualifying show.
Max height of fences 70cms. To be judged Single Phase. Fastest with least faults wins.
- Class 12 80cms TREASURE TROVE CHAMPIONSHIP**
Horse/Rider combination MUST have qualified at a TT qualifying show.
Two rounds. Max height of fences in first round 80cms. Max height of fences in jump off 85cms. All clears in the first round go through to jump off against the clock. Fastest in round 2 with least faults wins.
WINNER TO RECEIVE A RUG
- Class 13 90cms TREASURE TROVE CHAMPIONSHIP**
Horse/Rider combination MUST have qualified at a TT qualifying show.
Max height of fences 95cms in second half of the course. To be judged Single Phase. Fastest with least faults wins.
- Class 14 1.00m TREASURE TROVE CHAMPIONSHIP**
Horse/Rider combination MUST have qualified at a TT qualifying show.
Max height of fences 105cms in second half of the course. To be judged Single Phase. Fastest with least faults wins.

ENTRIES	On-line entries ashwoodequestrian.com . Entries close Thursday 3rd April 2025 at midnight. Approx start times given Friday 4th April 2025. ashwoodequestrian.com/times . STRICTLY NO HORSE OR PONY ALLOWED IN THE COLLECTING RING UNLESS PRE-ENTERED. Run under BS Rules 2025 with the exception of 3 refusals for elimination.
ARENA 1 PRIZES	All prize winners must come forward for a mounted presentation or will forfeit their placing and prize.
COURSE WALK	The course will be available for walking at the start of each class.
WITHDRAWALS, REFUNDS & SUBSTITUTIONS	Withdrawals for credit only will be considered before close of entries. Substitution of horse or rider is possible. Changing both horse & rider in the same entry qualifies as a whole new entry & must be paid in full.
DRESS CODE	Correct show jumping dress, with the exception of Show Jackets during inclement weather. Clean & Tidy please. No yard boots. Hard hats conforming to the current British Standard must be worn at all times when mounted. Plaiting is optional. NO SCHOOLING WHIPS AT ANY TIME.

TERMS & CONDITIONS Save for death or injury by the negligence of the organiser or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, Ashwood Equestrian Ltd, for themselves, their servants, agents, employees and all those connected with the event do not accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury, illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or statutory duty in any way whatsoever of themselves, their servants, agents, employees and all those connected with the event or otherwise. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising thereto. The organiser does not insure the rider, your horse or your tack and equipment. You are strongly advised to have in place your own adequate personal accident insurance at all times.

The decision of the Judges is final. If any person wishes to lodge a complaint, this must be done so in writing within 30 minutes of the incident along with a deposit of £50 (which will be returned if the complaint is upheld).

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry and to remove anyone from the venue at any time without giving a reason, amend the details of the schedule should it become necessary, or to cancel any class with insufficient entries. Once a class has been entered, refunds will not be given.

GENERAL RULES

1. All classes are open to juniors or seniors riding horses or ponies.
2. Horses/Ponies must be 4 years old or older.
3. Any horse/pony considered to be unsound, unfit or unhealthy by a Judge or the Organiser will be excluded from the competition without refund of entry.
4. No horseboxes to be mucked out on site.
5. It is compulsory that every person at the venue who is under the age of 18 years of age is accompanied by a responsible adult.
6. No dogs will be allowed in or around any of the arenas or on the cross country course, they must stay in the lorry park or preferably remain at home. Please clean up after you dogs AND TAKE YOUR POO BAGS HOME.
7. The event may be cancelled without notice due to adverse weather. In the event of adverse weather it is recommended that you check the website www.ashwoodequestrian.com for any announcements. In the unlikely event of abandonment, entries may be carried over to a future event or refunded minus £5 admin fee.
